## ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be a college-bound senior of Hudson High School in the year of application. The application must be submitted to the Office of Prevention Programs in Room 30 of the high school no later than April 28. Two individuals will be selected to receive \$1,000 each toward the college of their choice. Award shall be given on basis of scholarship, as evidenced by academic standing, leadership, character attributes, and community involvement. Payment of the award will be made payable to the college of choice soon after the recipient has been accepted at an accredited school.
